We want to personally thank you for your support of the Renovation Plan to date. We are now ready to secure the loan from the bank with plans to begin building activities second of quarter of this year.


Members have stepped out in faith believing that God will indeed make this project possible. We are now ready to step forth into the destiny which God has prepared for us.
